Taking the first step to housing stability

Homeless and discouraged, Dawn faced several challenges as she tried to find safe and stable housing for herself and her two-year-old son. Both mother and son suffered from chronic health conditions, she received minimal family support, and her history as a renter was marred by eviction notices. That all changed when Dawn moved into a local family shelter, began a new job, and connected with a Primary Health Care Housing Navigator. Thanks to this service — funded by the **Stable Steady Strong** initiative — Dawn, after several refusals, found a landlord who understood her unique situation. Additionally, the service's client assistance funds paid her deposit and her first month's rent, which she did not have, and which previously had prevented her from securing a new home. End of story? Not at all! This is just the beginning of a new chapter in Dawn and her son's life.
