

PSS 2020/2021 Funding Summary

Total Awards: \$510,000

Anawim Housing -- Permanent Supportive Housing Match component of HUD Permanent Supportive Housing (Shelter Plus Care) funds

- PCHTF Award: \$60,000
- Funding supports: This is the largest Permanent Supportive Housing program in Polk County and serves mainly persons with physical or mental disabilities. It is primarily funded by federal HUD dollars through the Continuum of Care. HUD requires the community match a certain amount of the cost of case management in order to leverage the federal funds. PCHTF has participated in providing the local match for over a decade.

Anawim Housing -- Expanding Choices in Housing Opportunities (ECHO)

- PCHTF Award: \$50,000
- Funding supports: This is a newer program encouraged by PCHTF and the Continuum of Care to open Permanent Supportive Housing slots (see the first Anawim Program) by transitioning folks needing less support into the Housing Choice Voucher Program (rent subsidy) but providing a lighter case management touch.

Beacon of Life

- PCHTF Award: \$10,000
- Funding supports: This is a Transitional Housing Program for women with addiction issues who were formerly incarcerated. PCHTF support is for the case management component.

Central Iowa Shelter and Services – Critical Time Intervention

- PCHTF Award: \$55,000
- Funding supports: This is support for the case management component of what is commonly known as the Second Floor, 38 Permanent Supportive Housing apartments above the Homeless Shelter. Rent subsidy is provided by Housing Choice Vouchers.

Dorothy's House – Front Porch Program

- PCHTF Award: \$22,000

- Funding supports: This is a Transitional Housing Program for survivors of sex trafficking. Funding will support case management for participants.

Greater Des Moines Habitat for Humanity

- PCHTF Award: \$25,000
- Funding supports: Financial and Homeowner Education and coaching to participants denied from Habitat homeownership program and other families in habitat program as well as referrals

Hawthorn Hill – The Home Connection

- PCHTF Award: \$55,000
- Funding supports: This is a Permanent Supportive Housing program for 36 families. Funding pays for case management. Rent is paid by the families.

Hawthorn Hill – New Directions Shelter

- PCHTF Award: \$10,000
- Request funds: This is a 30 day family homeless shelter. Funding pays for case management.

HOME, Inc. – Community Housing Services Program

- PCHTF Award: \$30,000
- Funding supports: This grant is a temporary bridge grant to support administrative and staff costs for the HOME Inc to manage the hotline for tenants and homeowners facing eviction or foreclosure. These costs will be paid through federal COVID relief funds as soon as those funds become available. \$30,000 will pay costs for approximately 90 days. PCHTF will end as soon as agency contracts for federal dollars.

HOME, Inc. – Hope for Stable Families

- PCHTF Award: \$25,000
- Funding supports: Hope for Stable Families is a Permanent Supportive Housing Program for families with K-12 age children. The goal is educational stability for students. This funding covers a portion of the program's case management cost. Rental assistance is provided by federal funds through the State of Iowa.

House of Mercy

- PCHTF Award: \$13,000
- Funding supports: This is a Transitional Housing program for women and children. This funding supports case management for families living in scattered site apartments after they leave inpatient treatment.
 - includes continued support of counselors and group sessions

Oakridge – Transitions

- PCHTF Award: \$50,000
- Funding supports: The goal of Transitions is to create a supportive workforce development platform to best serve the needs of families with young and school-aged children (0-15). Funding supports the cost of programming.

Primary Health Care -- Client Assistance (FKA Tenant Fund) a revolving fund managed by Centralized Intake used to help offset financial barriers to permanent housing

- PCHTF Award: \$50,000
- Funding supports: This fund is available to PHC as a way to satisfy financial barriers to housing such as deposits, applications and utility arrearages.

Primary Health Care – Landlord Mitigation

- PCHTF Award: \$5,000
- Funding supports: mitigating and rectifying issues and damages to apartments to allow for tenants to stay housed

YMCA Supportive Housing – Graduate Housing Program

- Award: \$50,000
- Funding supports: This new program encourages residents of the Y facility to move to scattered site housing around the community. The funding pays for continued case management and supportive services from Y staff outside of the campus. Next year the goal is support 12 Graduates.
