Shelter Plus Care	Individuals Families (171)	<30%	\$130,000	Community match and additional support for HUD-funded permanent supportive housing administered by Anawim Housing. Supportive services for formerly homeless individuals and families focused on increasing earned income, including job readiness and placement. Last year this program increased clients' earnings by almost \$350,000.
Permanent Supportive Housing	Individuals (38)	<30%	\$33,000	Supportive services for individuals permanently housed at CISS through Section 8 program. Program designed to lead to individual self-sufficiency through education, job training and financial empowerment.
Blueprint to Homeownership	Families (28)	<60%	\$70,000	Every Greater Des Moines Habitat for Humanity family is required to complete the Blueprint to Homeownership prior to the purchase of a Habitat home.
The Home Connection	Families (37)	<30%	\$70,000	Supportive services to formerly homeless families delivered by Hawthorn Hill. Services include financial and parenting education, job placement and training and tenant's rights and responsibilities.
Unity Place	Individuals (31)	<30%	\$30,000	Supportive services to formerly homeless single women residing in Mainstream Living's permanent supportive housing facility.
Transitions	Individuals (200)	<30%	\$48,500	Supportive Services to increase workforce readiness and participation for refugees and others residing in the Oakridge Neighborhood.
Foreclosure Defense Project	Families (18)	<60%	\$30,000	Supportive services from Iowa Legal Aid to assist homeowners in default modify the terms of their mortgages to make payments affordable based on their current economic circumstances.
Housing Navigator	Individuals Families (450)	<30%	\$100,000	Assistance to formerly or imminently homeless households in locating and obtaining affordable housing and follow up supportive services to help keep those clients housed.
Advantage Services	Families (100)	<60%	\$28,500	Comprehensive supportive services to families living in affordable housing owned by CommonBond Communities to increase neighborhood engagement and to improve students educational outcomes through afterschool homework help.
